**Lillian University Elects Newest Board Member**

Garson, Ontario, October 11, 2007 - Lillian University's newest member of the Board of Trustees Solange Nadieu, founder and President of SolWorks Worldwide, was sworn in on October 10. Ms. Nadieu was elected to a five-year term and fills the vacancy left by Clifford Deck, who resigned earlier this year.

Peter Holbrooks, chairman of the board, said, "Solange Nadieu's experience in the global marketplace and extensive background in fundraising will help our University navigate our current evolution into a premiere educational setting with international impact. We are thrilled to have her insight, skill, and commitment to Lillian."

Ms. Nadieu founded SolWorks Worldwide, a consulting agency which works with banks and investment firms breaking into international financial markets, in 1985. Since then, it has grown from a three-person operation into an international firm with offices in six countries and \$25 million in annual revenues.

She formed the Nadieu Foundation in 1997 with the express goal to afford educational opportunities to capable students in financially stressed areas throughout Canada. The Nadieu Foundation awards grants to non-profit organizations which specialize in education. The Foundation recently created a new program to award direct student scholarships for international study.

Ms. Nadieu was born in Montreal and lived in Lyon, France for fifteen years. She graduated from Lillian University in 1972 where she earned a B.S. in Business Administration. She graduated from McGill University with an MBA from the Faculty of Management in 1978.
